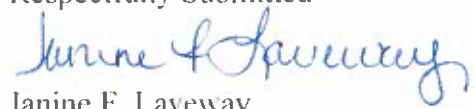


Town of Searsport, Maine
Select Board Meeting

June 4, 2024

1. Call to Order: 6:00pm
2. Pledge of Allegiance: Doug Norman, Chair led the Pledge of Allegiance
3. Roll Call: Doug Norman, Chair, Mark Bradstreet Vice Chair, Steve Tanguay, and Wes Norton are all present. Sandra Otis-Anderson was absent.
4. Announcements: None
5. Acceptance of Minutes: Motion: Wes Norton made a motion to accept the minutes for the May 7, 2024 select board meeting and the May 16, 2024 special select board meeting as written. Second by Mark Bradstreet Vote : 4-0-0. Motion by Mark Bradstreet to table the minutes from the annual town meeting until the next select board meeting. Seconded by Steve Tanguay. Vote: 4-0-0.
6. Acceptance of the agenda: James added 4 11th hour items to the agenda. Wes Norton made a motion to accept the agenda with the additional items added as 11th hour. Seconded by Steve Tanguay. Vote: 4-0-0
7. Public Comment: None
8. Old Business:
 - a. Liquor License renewal for Anglers Restaurant. James reported that there have been no complaints. Mark made a motion to approve the renewal of Anglers Restaurant's liquor license. Seconded by Steve. Vote: 4-0-0
9. New Business:
 - b. Disposition of Police Cruiser: James reported that the cruiser that is assigned to the school resource officer had a failure in the steering box. The repair is approximately \$3,000.00. Doug made a motion to approve spending up to \$3,000.00 to repair the cruiser. Seconded by Steve Vote: 4-0-0
10. 11th Hour
 - a. Local Food and Community Self-Governance Ordinance. Steve made a motion to place the local food and community self governance ordinance on the warrant for the 2025 annual town meeting. Seconded by Mark Vote: 4-0-0 Wes asked that the language be placed on the town website as soon as possible so residents can review it.
 - b. Roofing at the Public Works building. Wes made a motion to approve spending up to \$3,000.00 from the building reserve account to make the necessary repairs to the roof of the Storage building at the public works facility. Seconded by Steve Vote: 4-0-0
 - c. Representative to the Waldo County Budget Board Doug made a motion to nominate Wes Norton Seconded by Steve . Vote 3-0-1 Wes abstained
 - d. Cloud Permit Language update: James reported that there is language on the cloud permit site in the application section that identifies exposure for the applicant. Victor Mazza, CEO would like to add the following language: " I acknowledge that if I fail to comply with the Local Ordinances and the conditions of the permit I agree to fines of up to ten percent of the Value of the project as determined by the town." Doug made a motion to approve and Include the language as presented. Seconded by Steve Vote 4-0-0.
