Dear Sir or Madam,

If you are on our list as a daily "Call-In" to our center, you should call us daily (7 days a week) between the hours of **6:00 AM and 10:00 AM**. Call us at **1-800-660-3398 or 338-2040**. When you call please tell the dispatcher who answers the call who you are and that you are making your daily call.

Sometimes when you call, the dispatcher may not have time to talk with you and may seem abrupt, please do not think anything of that and just tell them who you are and that you are ok.

If you do not call us on any day we will call your home. If we do not make contact with you then we will send an officer / deputy to see if you are ok. It is very important that you call us ahead of time if you are not going to be able to call (ie going shopping, doctors appointment), also please notify us if you are planning a long vacation so we will not expect your call.

As soon as I get your informational sheet back we can get you started on the program. I will call you when we are ready to start. If you do not hear from me a few days after you send in the paperwork please do not hesitate to call me.

The number to call is **338-2040 or 1-800-660-3398**. If I am going to be out for those hours I will let the Communications Center know ahead of time. If I do not call someone will attempt to call me and / or my designated alternate person. Failure to reach you or someone you designate will result in an officer / deputy going to my home to check on my "Welfare". **Please drop this form off at the Searsport Police Department on Union St. in Searsport or if you are unable call 548-2304 and a Searsport police officer will pick it up.**
